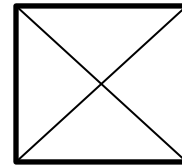
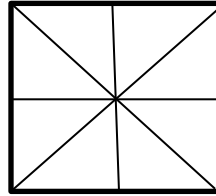
Colorado Block

Single Block Size: approx. 16 ½ inch square, untrimmed. Blocks should be returned untrimmed. Finished block will be 16 inch square. Yep, it's a big one!
Please use quality 100% cotton quilting fabric and ¼ inch seams.

For this block you will need two 10 inch squares of colorful fabrics and 2 10 inch white or off white squares, left over layer cake squares are perfect for this. Lay the colorful square on top of a white square RST (right sides together). Draw intersecting lines from corner to corner, it should look like this:

Stich ¼" seams along both sides of each line.

Cut squares apart along the lines and across and down, like this:
Press open.

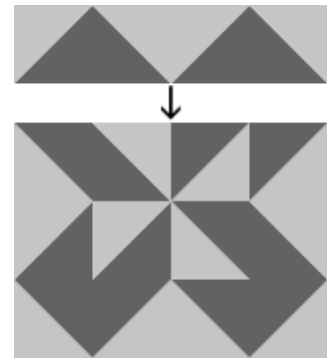
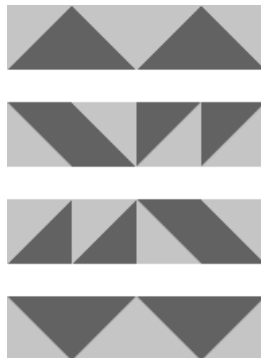
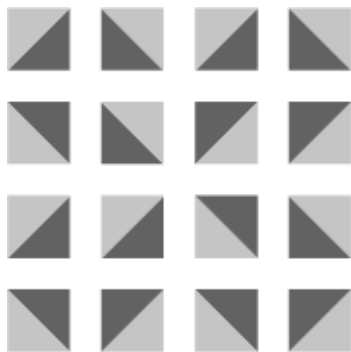


You will have a total of 16 HST (half square triangles)



Instructions:

Arrange the half-square triangles as shown below on left. With right sides together and using a scant 1/4" seam, sew together to form rows as shown in center diagram. Sew rows as shown on right to finish the block.
