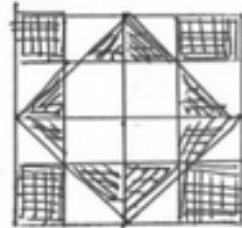


Half and Half Quilt

(from Missouri Quilt Company)

Block A (place light squares at center)



Finished Single Block Size: 12 inches. Do not square up at the end.

Please use quality 100% cotton quilting fabric and $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seams.

For this block you will need:

- In the kit is a 10-inch square of light fabric
- you will need to provide a contrasting 10-inch square. Think spring florals, to counter the winter's cold!

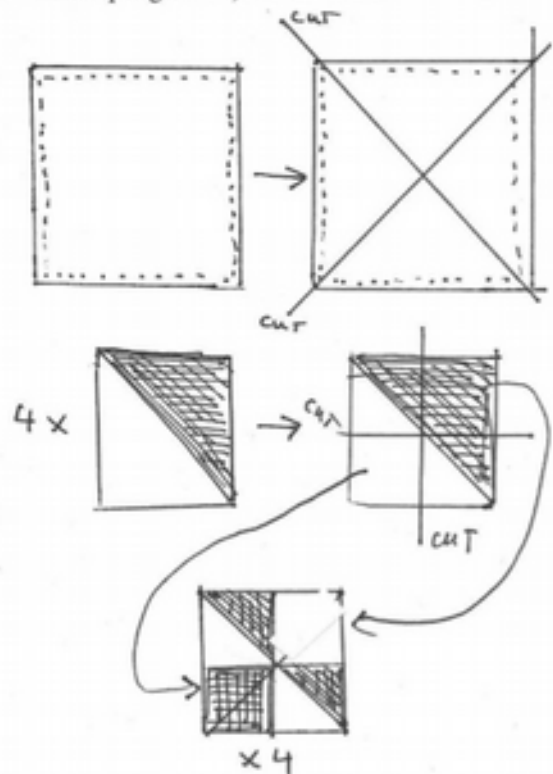
Instructions: Start with two 10-inch squares (one of your own and the one from the kit). Put right sides together, sew around the edge of the squares with a $\frac{1}{4}$ inch seam. Cut the square on the diagonals to get four half-square triangles. Press open.

Square the half-square triangles to $6\frac{1}{2}$ inches each

Take each of the half-square triangles and cut into four $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch pieces – two solid and two small half-square triangles. This will make a four-patch.

Swap or exchange the position of the solid color squares on each four-patch.

Now sew each four-patch to get four four-patches. Match the light squares at the center, and sew together to get one block
