

# Rising Star Quilters February 2018 Block of the Month

## Old Maid's Puzzle Block

Finished Single Block Size: 12 inch square
This month's block is the Old Maid's Puzzle Block
Please use quality $100 \%$ cotton quilting fabric and $1 / 4$ inch seams.

## For this block you will need:

- In the kit is an 8.5 inch by 19 inch piece of background fabric; this needs to be sub-cut into one 7.5 inch square; two 4.25 inch squares; and four 3.5 inch squares, provided
- you will need to provide two 4.25 inch squares and one 7.5 inch square, in a single coordinating solid fabric


## Instructions:

Take one 7.5 inch square each of background and solid and lay right sides together. On the wrong side of the bacground fabric, draw a diagonal line. Stitch a $1 / 4$ inch seam on either side of the drawn line, then cut along drawn line. Press seam allowance each half sqaure triangle (HST) toward the dark side. Press and trim to 6.5 inches square.

Repeat the process for creating HST with the 4.25 squares, resulting in four smaller HST. Square up each to 3.5 inches.

Layout your four blocks as shown in the above pictures (looks like 3 butterflies, large in the center and a smaller one in front and the other in the back).

DO NOT square up!
