# Rising Star Quilters November 2017 Block of the Month 

Please return your finished block(s) at the February $27^{\text {th }}$ meeting.

## Moonlight Star Block

Finished Block Size: 12 inch square
This month's block is the Moonlight Star block.
Please use quality $100 \%$ cotton quilting fabric and $1 / 4$ inch seams.

For this block you will need:

- In the kit is one 18 inch by 3 inch strip of light blue background; this needs to be sub-cut into six 2.875 inch squares, provided; 52 inches by 2.5 inches background fabric to be sub-cut into twenty 2.5 inch squares, provided; one 4.5 inch square, provided
- you will need to provide one piece of 18 inch by 8 inch of contrasting blue fabric to be sub-cut into four 4.5 inch squares and six 2.875 inch squares


## Instructions:

$\checkmark$ Pressing after each step it important for constructing this block - there are many seams!
$\checkmark$ Using the background and your blue 2.875 inch squares ( 6 each), create twelve halfsquare triangles (HST). Draw diagonal line across back of background squares, place right sides together with contrast blue and stitch $1 / 4$ inch either side of the diagonal line. Cut on drawn diagonal line, press to the dark side thus creating 2 HST's.
$\checkmark$ Create four corners as shown on the link below.
$\checkmark$ Snowball all four corners of each contrasting blue 4.5 inch squares. Trim and press to the dark side.
$\checkmark$ Create the final nine patch block according to the diagrams on the link below.
$\checkmark$ DO NOT square up - please let the block winner square
