# Rising Star Quilters March 2019 Block of the Month

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## Illusion Block

Finished Single Block Size: 12 by 7 inches. You will be making 2 blocks.
Please use quality $100 \%$ cotton fabric and $1 / 4$-inch seams.

## For one block you will need:

- one, $1 \frac{1}{2}$-inch strip of white fabric (provided), sub-cut into two $1 \frac{1}{2}$ - inch squares; one $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 11 \frac{1}{4}$-inch strip; and one $11 / 2 \times 7$-inch strip.
- one $11 / 2$ strip of gray fabric (provided), sub-cut into one $11 / 2 \times 9$-inch strip and one $1 \frac{1}{2} \times 5$-inch strip.
- one $5 \times 10$ rectangle of your choosing, preferably with a geometric print (no florals).


## Instructions:

Before beginning, remember that all sashing is attached on the left-hand side of the rectangles ONLY.

Refer to illustration of block for fabric placement.
Add one $11 / 2$-inch white square to one $11 / 2 \times 9$-inch strip of gray fabric. Press. Attach the strip (white square at the top) to left side of large rectangle and press to the dark.

Add one $11 / 2$-inch white square to one 5 -inch strip of gray fabric. Press, and attach to bottom edge of the rectangle. Note that the white square is on the opposite corner, diagonally, from the other white square attached in the previous step (see illustration). Press.

Attach $11 \frac{1}{1} 4$-inch strip of white fabric to the left edge of the block. Press.
Attach 7-inch strip of white fabric to bottom edge of block. Press.

## Please do NOT square up!
