

TRIANGLE BLOCKS FOR THE RSQ 2024 RAFFLE QUILT

Blocks are cut and sewn in groups of 2. Use a straight edge ruler for cuts, but please DO NOT measure precisely; we are aiming for a “wonky” look with some variation between blocks.

CUTTING AND SEWING BLOCKS

Stack the 2 rectangles.

1. Cut through the stack across the base between 1 inch and 1 and a 1/2 inches from the bottom. Set aside this base.
2. Make a second cut through the stack on a diagonal from about 1 and a 1/2 inches from the base side to the top. Set this side section aside.
3. Make a third cut through the stack from the other side.

Take the triangle left in the center and put it on the bottom.

Sew the triangles together in reverse order of cutting. 3,2, and 1. DO NOT TRIM.
