## Rising Star Quilt Guild Mystery Quilt 2020-21

## Clue \#5

This is the last set of clues! We complete block 2 first and then alternate blocks $1 \& 2$ to complete the design. You have probably already guessed how this block comes together to make a different $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " block.

## Completing Block 2

Using the remaining Flying Geese you made for Block 2, sew them onto opposite sides of the center block you made in Clue \#1. Make sure the point of the Flying Geese is facing out! Using 2 of the strip blocks you made last month (a flying geese with $21 / 2$ " squares on either end) and one of the center + flying geese strip you just made, sew 3 rows together to form the square block. Refer to the picture below if needed. Finished block is $\mathbf{8 1 / 2 "} \mathbf{X 8} \underset{1}{1 / 2 "}$ You will have 4 blocks for small quilt; 7 for rectangular; and 12 for the large quilt.

## Putting it all together

Starting with Block 1, alternate blocks in the row and the column. Row 1: B1,B2,B1; Row 2: B2, B1, B2, etc.

Here is how it will look with alternating Blocks A \& B together.


Add one or more borders as you wish to complete the quilt top. Choose a backing, sandwich, quilt, and bind to finish it off. Send pictures or bring to the next meeting so we can see your result!
